




JOBSWAP RISK, RESILIENCE & DEVELOPMENT

In this video, Oxford Innovations Elaine McKechnie, Commercial Director and Scargill, Business Development Director explain more about why they have both entered into a job swap, which had its origins in the military. The pandemic underlined the business needed to be more resilient and reduce the risks of events such as the pandemic. "We wanted to be able to support and cover each other as well as challenge each other." Explained Elaine.

Gareth added. "We wanted to develop our teams to provide a better pipeline of talent for the future. We also wanted to avoid 'knowledge voids' which occur when people leave the business, sometimes unexpectedly."

The role changes are described as 'formal secondments' and are encompassed in a one page document with those colleagues that want to take part. It really is very straightforward.



















Plan carefully to avoid the pain of death duties


