RISING TAX BURDEN THREATENS THAMES VALLEY GROWTH

ONE IN THREE (31%) MID-MARKET BUSINESSES BELIEVE THE INCREASED TAX BURDEN IS A TOP THREAT TO FUTURE GROWTH, ACCORDING TO A SURVEY AHEAD OF THE CHANCELLOR'S AUTUMN STATEMENT.

The findings from business advisory group Grant Thornton show that the increased tax burden is considered as big a challenge as digital security and cyber risk. They are based on the views of 605 businesses around the country.

Businesses have already been hit this year with the upcoming rise in corporation tax to 25%, announced in the March Budget, and the recent announcement of a rise in National Insurance from April 2022 to help fund the health and social care sectors...
